Backyard trapping tips:

- Set your trap(s) as soon as possible and keep them freshly baited (we recommend peanut butter or mayonaise).
- Write your trap number on the tunnel with a permanent marker.
- Check your traps every few days to start with, then once a week. If you're not catching anything, try a different location e.g. along fence lines or near the compost bin.
- Always wear gloves when handling traps and catches.
- Use the Trap.nz app to keep a record.
